Dr Susan Muto

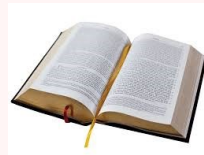


A native of Pittsburgh, Dr Susan Muto Ph.D is a renowned speaker, author, teacher and spiritual director. She began working with Fr Adrian van Kaam CSSp in the mid 1960s, and together they promoted spiritual formation at all levels of Church life. Together they began the Epiphany Association for the promotion of spirituality among clergy and laity.

As a single lay woman living her vocation in the world and doing full-time, church-related ministry in the Epiphany Association, Dr Muto has led conferences, seminars, workshops, and institutes throughout the world.

Drawing on Judeo-Christian classics from ancient to modern times, together with contemporary resources in the literature of spirituality, she aims in her teaching to integrate the life of prayer and presence with professional ministry and in-depth formation in the home, in the church and in the market-place.

In fidelity to the principles of van Kaam's original approach to faith and formation, she addresses in her teaching and publications the contemporary needs of laity, clergy and religious.



Dr Muto co-authored a number of books with Adrian van Kaam on various aspects of Christian formation and spirituality. Among their most important works are *Commitment: Key to Christian Maturity* and *The Poser of Appreciation: A New Approach to Personal and Relational Healing*.

In recent years, Dr Muto has written many books on the formative reading of Scripture and on the classical Christian authors. Her most recent book is called *Twelve Little Ways to Transform Your Heart: Lessons in Holiness and Evangelisation from St Therese of Lisieux*.
